2) The two men

BORUSIEWICZ, Marian
and KUCHARSKI, Josef

have no right whatsoever to be in any DP camp. They were screened here in August for emigration to Venezuela. They were subsequently rejected by the commission and applied for entrance to camp on the ground that the slip from Buzbach Emigration Centre directed them to return to their camp of origin.

As they have been living privately in Vieraheln since their discharge from Kaserfetal Guard Training Centre in January 1947. They by no means constitute a hardship case. When I told them this, they went to the area director, to whom I directed a letter (enclosed please find copy). They did not return. Now we discover that they have fraudulently entered one of your camps.

I have learnt quite a lot about these two men since they were led here. I propose, however, merely to include them on my next list of ineligible persons, as they are nominally still under the jurisdiction of this Control Centre.

I enclose for you rejection slips for the two men. I suppose they did not show you their slips from here saying that they had DP status for work and emigration. I should be glad if you would withdraw those from them at the same time as the DP cards.
