All these individuals have been screened and accepted by Mr. Lanata-Caudy, Peruvian Consul, for repatriation to Peru. In addition, all individuals have been cleared by the US Political Advisor at USFET and with the US State Department, and are eligible to leave the US zone of Germany for repatriation to Peru on the Peruvian vessel HIMAQ, departing from Antwerp, Belgium, 20 Nov. 1946. The individuals will report to the Peruvian Embassy, Paris, on arrival for further transportation from Paris to Antwerp. This movement has been cleared by Headquarters 3rd. US Army, Headquarters USFET, and the Combined Repatriation Executives in Berlin, by special arrangement with the office of the Theatre Chief of Transportation. This is an authorized US Army Displaced Persons movement and the cost of rail transportation from Frankfurt to Paris will be borne by the War Department.
