To: Commanding Officer, 353rd A.A.A. (A.W.) Bn.

1. The death of one Mikelis Krumbergs, a Latvian displaced person of the above named camp is hereby reported.

2. Circumstances surrounding his death is as follows:

"Mikelis Krumbergs was discovered on the morning of 19 Aug. 1945 as having passed away sometime during the night of 18-19 Aug. 1945. The camp physician, Dr. J. Knezinskis, examined the body and it is his opinion that the man died of a heart attack, the time of death is estimated to be about 0500 Hrs. 19 August. The deceased's age of sixty-eight years supports the opinion that he died of a heart attack."

3. Disposal of the body and reporting of pertinent information to the proper civilian authorities has been made the responsibility of the burgo-master of Königsfeld.
