✓ WELUS, Stanislaw, born May 23, 1943, admitted March 19, 1945 *Muddled*

Stanislaw seemed at first very disturbed, never wanted to stay by himself, and showed signs of fright at a noise or the dark (possible effect of a bombardment).

Soon he was making good progress, felt more secure, and was more responsive. He eats well, feeds himself. His habits are not quite established. He understands German but speaks only a few words. He is very sensitive and needs very gentle handling.

✓ HAILUGA, Armin, born January 29, 1944, admitted September 8, 1945 *Polish*

Having been discharged from a hospital, he came to us in rather poor condition. Picked up very soon and is now a very normal child with good habits. He eats well, feeds himself, and is beginning to talk.

✓ WIROSCWITSCHERKO, Barbara, born ?; admitted March 19, 1945

I think Barbara is a little over two. She was very aggressive and one had the impression of a very spoiled child. A lot of crying and kicking. Was terribly starved and still can never get enough food. She is much calmer, needs a lot of love and understanding. Good habits, understands German, speaks German, a very bright and contented child on the whole.

✓ PIATEK, Jura, born April 17, 1944, admitted October 1, 1945 *very stupid* *Polish 3/15/47*

Retarded child, very passive disposition, very slow progress at first. Getting along very well at the moment. He is just starting to walk, beginning to talk in German.

✓ BOVDVORSEAYA, Georg, born December 19, 1943, admitted September 1, 1945

*undetermined*  
Very undersized and in poor condition, terribly starved. Improved rapidly. Very happy child with a good disposition. Good habits, feeds himself, still wants a lot to eat. Understands German and is starting to talk. Needs a lot of love, seems to grow under it.

✓ SIBUZIKOWNA, Johann, born July 28, 1943, admitted September 4, 1945

Very normal child, a little aggressive, cries easily.

Has developed a lot, seems much happier, occupies himself better. Very bright, speaks and understands a little Polish, understands and speaks well in German. Has good eating and other habits.

✓ PLEYAO, Rosemarie, born May 30, 1943, admitted September 24, 1945

Was discharged from a hospital. Was very quiet at first and a poor eater.
